

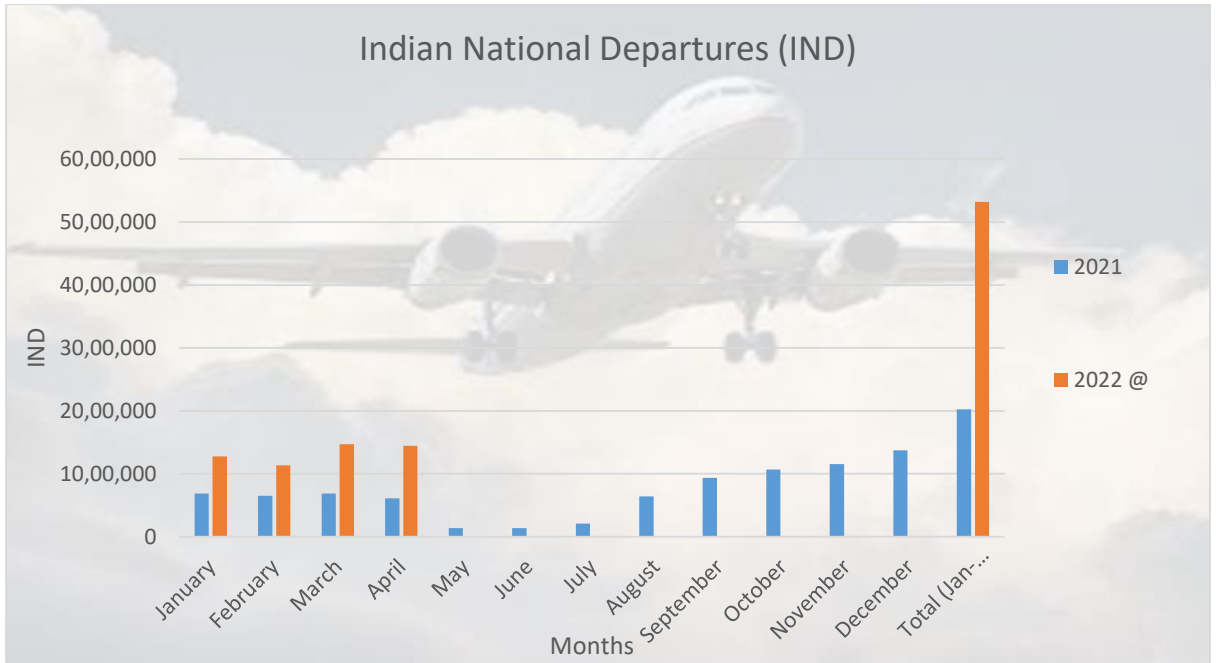
Indian National Departures April, 2022

Ministry of Tourism compiles monthly Indian National Departures (INDs) 2022 (Provisional) on the basis of information received from Bureau of Immigration (BOI).

The following are the important highlights regarding Destination wise Indian National Departures (INDs) Provisional during the month of April, 2022:

Indian Nationals Departures (INDs):

- INDs in April 2022 were 14,45,197 as compared to 6,34,663 in April 2021 registering a growth of 127.7%.
- INDs during the period January- April, 2022 were 53,21,358 as compared to 26,86,110 in January- April, 2021 registering a growth of 98.1%.
- The percentage share of Destination wise Indian National Departures from India during April 2022 among the top 15 destination countries was highest from UAE (30.10%) followed by Saudi Arabia (12.20%), USA (8.81%), Canada (5.23%), Singapore (4.53%), Qatar (4.26%), Kuwait (4.01%), UK (3.81%), Oman (3.64%), Australia (2.72%), Bangladesh (2.01%), Thailand (1.82%), Bahrain (1.75%), Maldives (1.75%) and Nepal (1.40%).
- The percentage share of Destination wise Indian National Departures from India during January-April 2022 among the top 15 destination countries were highest from UAE (32.74%) followed by Saudi Arabia (12.32%), USA (8.62%), Qatar (5.02%), Kuwait (4.42%), UK (4.06%), Oman (4.03%), Canada (3.99%), Singapore (3.52%), Australia (2.17%), Bahrain (1.91%), Bangladesh (1.71%), Maldives (1.57%), Germany (1.24%), and Sri Lanka (1.15%).
