

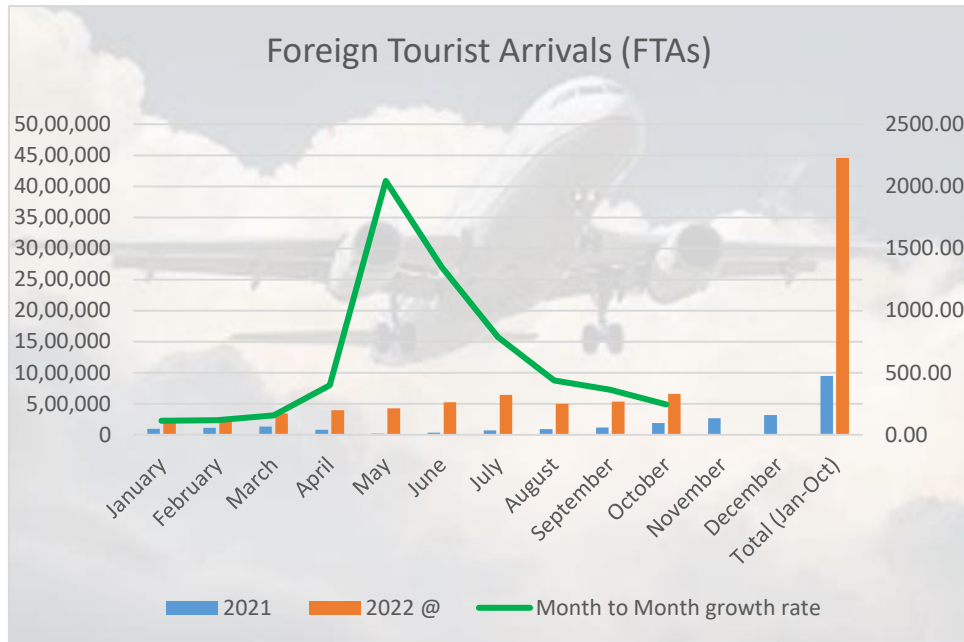
Foreign Tourist Inflow to India October, 2022

Ministry of Tourism compiles monthly Foreign Tourist Arrivals (FTAs) on the basis of information received from Bureau of Immigration (BOI). The following are the important highlights regarding FTAs during the month of October, 2022.

Foreign Tourist Arrivals (FTAs):

- FTAs in October, 2022 were 6,56,895 as compared to 1,91,415 in October, 2021 and 9,45,017 in October, 2019 registering a growth of 243.2% and -30.5% with respect to 2021 and 2019 respectively.
- FTAs during the period January- October, 2022 were 44,56,454 as compared to 9,45,600 in January-October, 2021 and 86,11,517 in January-October, 2019 registering a growth of 371.3% and -48.3% with respect to 2021 and 2019 respectively.
- The percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during October, 2022 among the top 15 source countries was highest from Bangladesh (21.77%), followed by USA (17.30%), UK (10.21%), Canada (4.92%), Australia (4.81%), Sri Lanka (2.87%), Germany (2.56%), Nepal (2.25%), France (2.19%), Russian Fed.(2.18%), Malaysia (1.99%), Singapore (1.71%), Japan (1.30%), Korea (Rep.of) (1.12%) and Thailand (1.07%).
- The percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during January- October, 2022 among the top 15 source countries was highest from USA (22.37%), followed by Bangladesh (20.64%), UK (10.41%), Australia (5.06%), Canada (4.42), Sri Lanka (3.16%), Nepal (2.40%), Germany (1.96%), France (1.87%), Malaysia (1.81%), Singapore (1.77%), Maldives (1.25%), Portugal (1.17%), Russian Federation (1.15%) & Oman (1.06%).
- The percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during October 2022 among the top 15 ports was highest at Delhi Airport (34.95%) followed by Mumbai Airport (13.93%), Haridaspur Land Check Post (10.06%), Chennai Airport (8.11%), Bengaluru Airport (5.56%), Kolkata Airport (3.49%), Cochin Airport (3.43%), Hyderabad Airport (3.32%), Ahmedabad Airport (2.62%), Ghojadanga Land Check Post (1.94%), Agartala Land Check Post (1.46%), Amritsar Airport (1.40%), Changrabandha Land Check Post (1.29%), Chitpur Rail Check Post (1.18%) and Hilli Land Check Post (1.14%) .
- The percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during January-October 2022 among the top 15 ports was highest at Delhi Airport (31.83%) followed by Mumbai Airport (13.62%), Chennai Airport (9.90%), Haridaspur Land Check Post

(9.64%), Bengaluru Airport (6.39%), Hyderabad Airport (4.93%), Cochin Airport (4.68%), Kolkata Airport (3.91%), Ahmedabad Airport (2.67%), Ghojadanga Land Check Post (1.49%), Agartala Land Check Post (1.44%), Trivandrum Airport (1.41%), Tiruchirappalli Airport (1.06%), Changrabandha Land Checkpost (0.99%) and Amritsar Airport (0.98%).
