

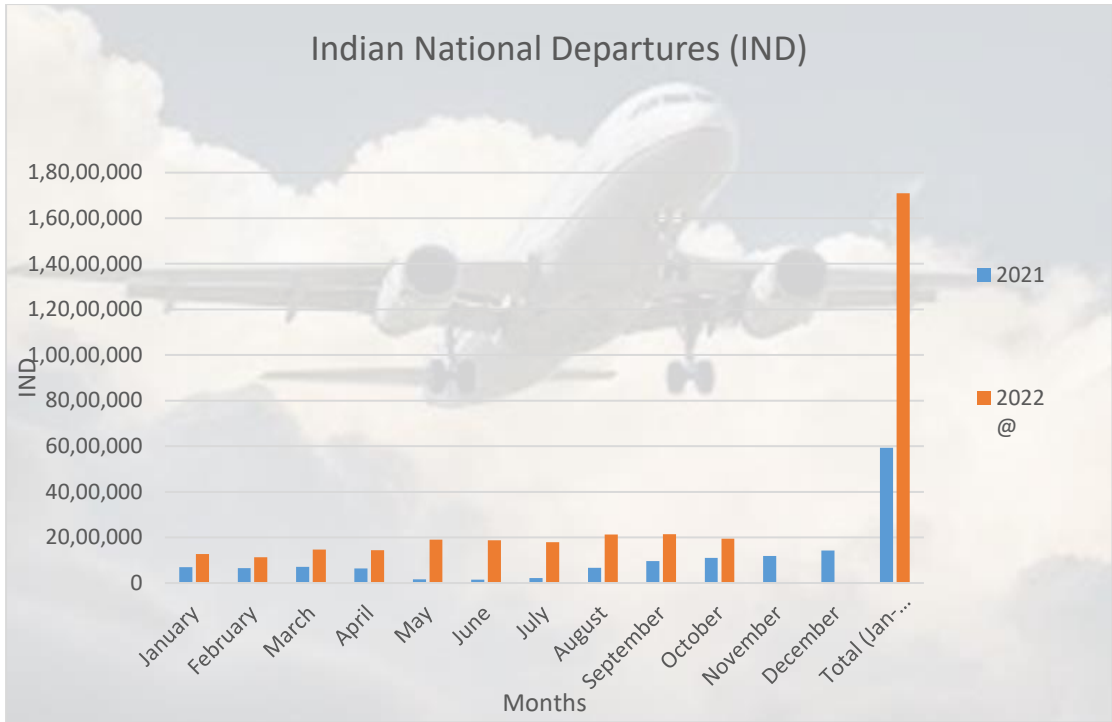
Indian National Departures October, 2022

Ministry of Tourism compiles monthly Indian National Departures (INDs) 2022 (Provisional) on the basis of information received from Bureau of Immigration (BOI).

The following are the important highlights regarding Destination wise Indian National Departures (INDs) Provisional during the month of October, 2022:

Indian Nationals Departures (INDs):

- INDs in October 2022 were 19,47,078 as compared to 10,96,257 in October 2021 and 21,45,065 in October 2019 registering a growth of 77.6 % and -9.2% with respect to 2021 and 2019 respectively.
- INDs during the period January- October, 2022 were 1,70,95,405 as compared to 59,35,127 in January- October , 2021 and 2,24,11,727 in January- October 2019 registering a growth of 188.0% and -23.7% with respect to 2021 and 2019 respectively.
- The percentage share of Destination wise Indian National Departures from India during October, 2022 among the top 15 destination countries was highest for UAE (28.22%) followed by Saudi Arabia (11.19%), Thailand (5.93%), USA (5.59), Singapore (5.20%), UK (4.80%), Qatar (3.85%), Kuwait (3.45%), Oman (2.96%), Canada (2.69%), Bangladesh (2.50%), Australia (2.08%), Malaysia (2.02%), Maldives (1.35%) and Germany (1.34%).
- The percentage share of Destination wise Indian National Departures from India during January-October, 2022 among the top 15 destination countries were highest for UAE (28.07%) followed by Saudi Arabia (11.62%), USA (8.35%), Singapore (4.58%), UK (4.50%), Qatar (4.29%), Kuwait (4.17%), Thailand (3.86%), Canada (3.63%), Oman (3.53%), Australia (2.19%), Bangladesh (2.08%), Bahrain (1.65%), Malaysia (1.40%) and Maldives (1.37%).
