

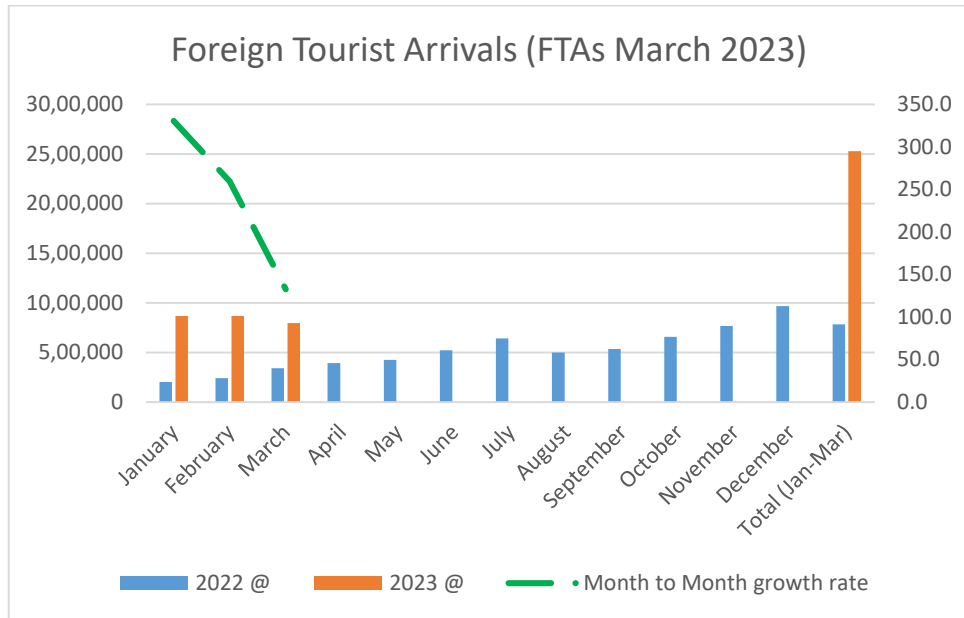
Foreign Tourist Inflow to India March, 2023

Ministry of Tourism compiles monthly Foreign Tourist Arrivals (FTAs) on the basis of information received from Bureau of Immigration (BOI). The following are the important highlights regarding FTAs during the month of March, 2023.

Foreign Tourist Arrivals (FTAs):

- FTAs in March, 2023 were 7,95,827 as compared to 3,42,308 in March, 2022 and 9,78,236 in March,2019 registering a growth of 132.5% and -18.6% with respect of 2023 and 2019 respectively.
- The percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during March, 2023 among the top 15 source countries was highest from Bangladesh (24.1%) followed by USA (14.4%), UK (10.8%), Canada (4.3%), Australia (4.2%), Sri Lanka (3.4%), Malaysia (2.8%), Germany (2.6%), Russian Federation (2.1%), Nepal (2.0%), France (2.0%), Singapore (1.8%), Thailand (1.5%), Japan (1.4%) and Italy (1.1%)
- The percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during March, 2023 among the top 15 ports was highest at Delhi Airport (31.72%) followed by Mumbai Airport (13.29%), Haridaspur Land Check Post (12.31%), Chennai Airport (7.91%), Bengaluru Airport (5.24%), Kolkata Airport (3.16%), Cochin Airport (2.98%), Hyderabad Airport (2.87%), Ghojadanga Land Check Post (2.14%), Dabolim (Goa) Airport (1.96%), Ahmedabad Airport (1.79%), Agartala Land Check Post (1.77%),Amritsar Airport (1.44%), Changrabandha Land Check Post (1.34%), and Sonauli Land Check Post (1.34%) .
- FTAs during the period January-March 2023 were 25,29,766 as compared to 7,84,750 in January-March, 2022 and 31,79,792 in January-March 2019 registering a growth of 222.4% and -20.4% with respect of 2023 and 2019 respectively.
- The percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during January-March, 2023 among the top 15 source countries was highest from Bangladesh (20.85%), USA (16.85%), UK (10.56%), Canada (5.40%), Australia (4.52%), Sri Lanka (2.95%), Malaysia (2.76%), Russian Federation (2.59%), Germany (2.52%), France (2.20%), Nepal (1.94%), Singapore (1.57%), Thailand (1.44%), Japan (1.28%) and Italy (1.19%).
- The percentage share of Foreign Tourist Arrivals in India during January-March, 2023 among the top 15 ports was highest at Delhi Airport (31.05%) followed by Mumbai Airport (15.72%), Haridaspur Land Check Post (10.29%), Chennai Airport (7.81%), Bengaluru Airport (5.40%), Cochin Airport (3.29%), Kolkata

Airport (3.24%), Hyderabad Airport (3.19%), Dabolim (Goa) Airport (2.58%), Ahmedabad Airport (2.54%), Ghojadanga Land Check Post (1.74%), Agartala Land Check Post (1.40%) Amritsar Airport (1.33%), Changrabandha Land Check Post (1.29%), and Chitpur Rail (1.18%).
